WHAT TO EXPECT WHEN IN COSTA RICA

Show your Health Pass QR code to officials at the airport. Wear a mask, social distance and use hand sanitizer at the airport, in hotels, on transfers and tours.

Restaurants, businesses, tours, bars, casinos and hotels are open. Typically, common areas abide to 50% capacity. Some have additional rules they must follow by law. Signs will be posted and staff will answer questions.

Beaches are open from 5AM-6PM typically. Driving is permitted from 5AM-11PM and tourist rental cars are exempt. Costa Rica follows the social bubble concept-stay with the people you are traveling.

Wear your mask when shopping and for most touring experiences. Shops take this seriously because they can be fined if their customers are not wearing one. Guests do not need to wear a mask in restaurants while seated.

You will notice guides, drivers, hotel staff, servers, rental car agencies and tour personnel will be wearing masks and follow strict cleaning procedures to keep you safer. Hotels have strict protocols for common areas and room cleaning. Transfer drivers follow cleaning procedures for vehicles.

Private tours and small groups are common. Larger groups are limited to their social bubble.

Wash your hands or use sanitizer entering and exiting parks, shops and any tourism facility.
